FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Hi everyone and welcome back to the start of the new school term. It is very rewarding to report the enthusiasm and excitement seen in our students across all levels of the school as they reconnect to their learning. This week I had the opportunity to visit the Year 2 students to speak about the role of a Principal and the typical jobs that are completed on a daily basis. This was a wonderful session focusing on people in the community, how they help us and the roles they perform. I congratulate the students for their well thought out questions and display of excellent attitudes towards their learning.

We want our students to tell us what they think!

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what your child thinks of our school. The Attitudes to School survey is an annual survey for Years 5 and 6 students offered by the Department of Education and Training. It is designed to assist our school in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. Our school will use the survey results to plan programs and activities to improve your child's experience at school.

All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year the Attitudes to School survey will be conducted at our school over the period Monday 18th April to Friday 29th April. The survey only takes 20-30 minutes to complete and occurs during your child's class time. The survey results will be reported back to the school at the end of July. The survey results will be communicated to parents through the annual reporting meeting on Wednesday 15th June (details to follow). Please speak to your child's teacher if you would like more information.


