### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

#### Premier and Deputy Premier's visit to Cranbourne East Primary School

On Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> March we hosted a special visit by the Hon Daniel Andrews MP, Premier of Victoria, the Hon James Merlino MP, Deputy Premier and Minister for Education and Jude Perera MP, Member of the Victorian Legislative Assembly for Cranbourne. The purpose of the visit was to launch the 2016 Premiers Reading Challenge.

Our school captains Estelle and Joel met our guests and welcomed them to the school. The Principal and Assistant Principal, Mrs Wrigley then met the guests and toured the Year 1 Learning Neighbourhood to view the CAFÉ reading program (Comprehension, Accuracy, Fluency and Expression learning activities). The Premier took the opportunity to speak with students about their learning, view the learning space and devices (computers and iPads) used to support learning, meet the teachers and listen to students read.

It was then a short visit to the Library to meet the 2015 Premiers Reading Challenge Champions: Mason, Luka, Samantha, Keira and Prabhu along with Estelle and Joel to hear about their thoughts on their learning, enjoyment of reading and what they like most about school. The Premier and Deputy Premier were highly impressed with Nuha's excellent reading ability and her journey arriving from Lebanon with very little English language and through her incredible efforts and engagement in her learning (including the Premier's Reading Challenge) achieved excellent reading skills and achievement.

I commend our students for their confidence and ability to clearly articulate their thoughts about their learning in school, praise for teachers, high level interest in their learning, modern facility and resources available to support learning. Our students made us proud and the Premier, Deputy Premier and Jude Perera were most impressed in all respects. Following a photo shoot and Channel 7 interview with the Premier, the Department photographers also took photos for the Department's website promoting the Reading Challenge (photos are to be published on the school website when available). I thank Mrs Wrigley for her planning of the visit, Ms Harding (Librarian) for her wonderful displays and all staff who came together to prepare the school for the visit. My thanks also acknowledge our On Site Service Assistant, Glenn, for his work in making the grounds look extra special on the day.

All students are encouraged to take the Premier's Reading Challenge, so with parent permission, register, log in and record what books you have read then vote for your favourite book. Most of the books you read should be from the Challenge book list. If you meet the Challenge this year, the Premier of Victoria will send you a certificate of achievement. To meet the Challenge students in Foundation (Prep) to Year 2 need to read 30 books while students in Year 3 to Year 6 need to read 15 books. The website contains Additional information which is to be sent home shortly along with the parent consent form. Students can read by themselves or with parents, teacher, brother or sister, classmate, buddy, friend, grandparents, relatives and friends. The Challenge is now open and closes on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2016.

Bryan is a Registered Psychiatric Nurse with 20 years of clinical experience in a range of senior positions in Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services in Scotland and now Australia. Bryan is an engaging speaker who provides excellent insight into the mind of children and how to support their mental development from their early years through to young adulthood. Bryan enables the audience to leave his presentations with clear and understood strategies to support children who might display anxiety and other behavioral tendencies that affect their everyday functioning.


Bryan has been working with the staff at Cranbourne East Primary School delivering engaging and informative professional development sessions. Bryan will continue to work with the staff this year on wellbeing strategies that support students at CEPS.

The parent session will cover various topics related to how a child's brain works, the effect of daily stress, why children get upset and how parents can help their children to manage.

This session will be highly informative and not to be missed. As an international speaker Bryan's sessions fill quickly so please return your reply slip so you do not miss this event.

Remember the 5 SMART rules when using the internet and mobile phones.

- S SAFE:** Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information – such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name – to people you are chatting with online.
- M MEET:** Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.
- A ACCEPTING:** Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages!
- R RELIABLE:** Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are. Make sure you check information before you believe it.
- T TELL:** Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.
