NAPLAN tests assess literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life and provide schools, education authorities and governments with information about how education programs are working and whether young Australians are meeting important educational outcomes in literacy and numeracy. Parents will receive an individual report on their child's NAPLAN achievement later in the year.

It has been wonderful to see many members of our school community enjoying the opportunity to grab themselves a nice warm coffee, tea or hot chocolate from the coffee van on these chilly mornings, however a reminder that for safety reasons, no primary school students should be entering the carpark area to purchase hot chocolates without a parent or guardian present.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors; excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families.

The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

If you are eligible, please complete the application form available from the school office.

Application forms should be returned by Friday 29th June, 2018. This will ensure that funds are available for your child/ren to use for upcoming excursions, camps and school-based activities.
