FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Hi everyone

On behalf of the School Council and staff I extend a very warm welcome to our new families and to our existing families as we return to school to commence Term 2. The term is already shaping up to be another exciting time for learning as we look forward to swimming programs, camps, visits and much more.

This week I met with delegates from the City of Casey and leadership team from Cranbourne East Secondary College to discuss the matter of parking around both schools including traffic flow and management. While no immediate solutions were provided to alleviate the issues, we do remind families about some of the simple strategies which include parking a short distance from the school and walking with your children, keeping No Parking zones clear (this is enforceable by the City of Casey Bi-laws and police) and adopting a patient approach when in traffic. The opening of the sports complex next to the school early in 2019 will provide approximately 75 additional parking bays which may relieve some of the traffic pressure around the school. The City of Casey did mention a supervised crossing is to be installed on Corrigans Road in the vicinity of the bend near Marnabek School in the coming months. We will be reconvening for a meeting mid year to again address the issues of parking around the school.

Please note I will be on long service leave commencing Monday 23rd April for a period of four weeks. During my leave Mrs Michelle Wrigley will be Acting Principal.

Today we rehearsed our Lockdown Drill as part of the school emergency management planning. I thank all students, staff and visitors for your timely support to the rehearsal. Prior to any Lockdown or Evacuation rehearsal all staff discuss with our students why we rehearse the drills and what can be expected to happen during the drills.

Please ensure your child attends school every day (unless ill) and arrives on time each day to commence their learning. It is also vital your child develops positive routines at home and read on a daily basis even on weekends and holidays.

There will be a meeting of the Parents Association at the school on Monday evening commencing 7:00pm and we encourage parents to come along and assist with fundraising events. There is no workload, only a willingness and enthusiasm to be part of a team – we look forward to seeing you there.

Please note the ANZAC Day ceremony at the Clydesdale Square, main street Cranbourne next Wednesday commencing 10:30am. Our School captains will be laying a wreath on behalf of the school community.

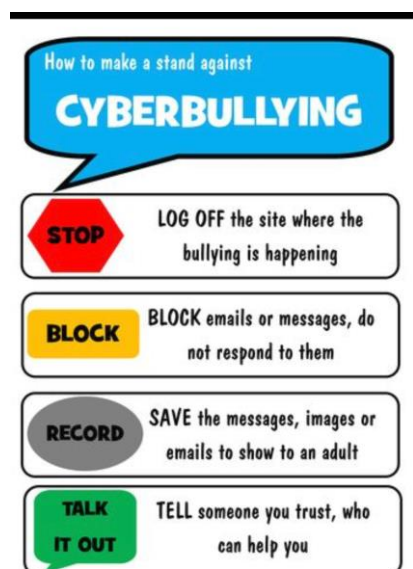
From the Wellbeing Officer

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors; excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families.

The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students

If you are eligible, please complete the application form available from the school office.

Application forms should be returned by Friday 29th June, 2018. This will ensure that funds are available for your child/ren to use for upcoming excursions, camps and school-based activities.

2018 CSEF PREP WINTER UNIFORM PACKAGE

Applications for Prep Uniform Vouchers of students who are eligible for CSEF are now open.

If your child is eligible, information will be sent home this week. You will be required to measure your child's foot and complete the shoe order form, along with the sizing of tops and tracksuit pants.

When you return the forms to the office, an order will be processed by the school. Your child will receive the goods when they arrive. Vouchers will be sent home to parents when received.
