## From the Welfare Officer

### RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS AT CEPS

Our school continues its work around the Respectful Relationships curriculum that has been introduced to all Victorian schools this year. Respectful Relationships is about tackling the issue of family violence through the schools and education introducing this work into their school community.

The learning our students participate in is developed around evidence-based materials and are designed to support teachers to help develop our students' social and emotional capabilities to promote positive, healthy and respectful relationships.

In our learning spaces, our students are learning about problem solving skills, how to develop empathy, supporting their own wellbeing and learning how to build healthy relationships with others. When children and teachers build positive relationships with each other, they feel happier and safer at school, are more resilient and have positive social attitudes. Positive relationships also increase a child's sense of social connectedness and belonging.

As a Partner School in the program, CEPS has been at the forefront of this important program and learning area and we have worked with a number of schools in the Casey South network as they go about introducing this work into their school community.
