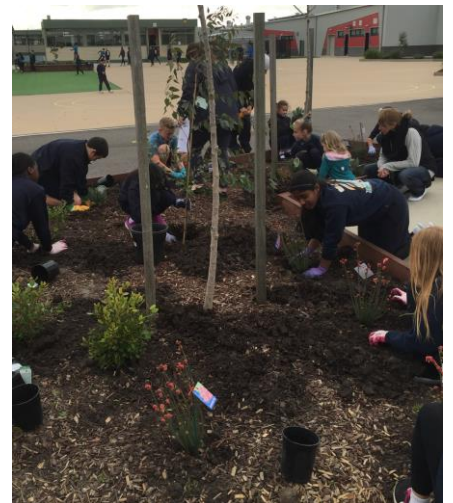
FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Cyber Smart- Stay safe

- Be careful who you trust on line. Making new friends can be fun, but there is a chance that they may not be who they say they are.
- Tell your parents if you are upset by language, pictures or anything scary on the Internet.
- Always keep your password a secret.
- Think before you post information online- once posted it is always there.
- Don't open messages from people you don't know. These could contain viruses.
- Ask your parents before you give anyone on the Internet your name address or any personal details.
- If someone is nasty, offensive or makes you feel uncomfortable in a chat room, don't respond and leave straight away. You can report the situation to the website or Internet service provider and ask them to remove the content.

Tips for parents:

It is vital that you have regular open communication with your children about what they do online. Establish rules about online use (e.g. Always use the internet in a family space) and monitor compliance with those rules. Agree that your child will always treat others with respect online, and let you know if anything happens that upsets them. Familiarise yourself with how to report inappropriate content on social media sites.

Note: The minimum age that children are allowed by law to access social media sites including Facebook and YouTube is 13 years old.
