Hi Everyone

These activities don't just happen, they take a considerable amount of work and I must acknowledge and thank the staff and parents for your support. I am confident in saying by the enthusiasm shown in our students there would have been many happy Dads on Sunday.

Thank you to all of our staff including the special events team of teachers for their preparation of our Father's Day school open session of activities. It was wonderful to see so many parents turn up for the session and participate in a variety of fun games and tasks with their children.

This week we farewelled our first group of Year 6 students as they set off for a week of camp activities at Woorabinda. Even though we have experienced an unusual bout of cold and wet weather this has not stopped our staff and students from having an enormous amount of fun while enjoying all the exciting experiences of a school camp. I have spoken to Mr Welsch every day and he reports everyone is well and the camp is so much fun.

The school Leadership Team is continuing to plan all aspects of school operations for the 2018 school year and request parents contact the school office should you be enrolling students at the school next year or transferring students from the school. This will greatly assist the planning process ensuring we have the right number of teachers and specialists, rooms and resources in place. Please note the school has a neighbourhood boundary in place. Thank you for your support with this request.

Have you heard of the ACE Foundation? The ACE (Aiding Casey Education) Foundation is a newly established *not for profit* Foundation which exists solely on donations. Leon Shapero (a local Doctor) established the ACE Foundation in 2014. He has worked in Cranbourne since 1987 and has close ties with many local schools including Cranbourne East Primary School. The ACE Foundation vision is to assist students of any age in the City of Casey who are experiencing significant challenges in their educational pursuits. These challenges may be either cultural, language, socio-economic, physical or family fracture related etc. The ACE Foundation have invited students in Year 1 and Year 2 to participate in a Vision Testing Program. All we require is for parents to sign permission slips and the ACE Foundation will arrange for the optometrist to visit the school and test each child. Any child requiring glasses ACE will pay for them FREE of charge to the parents. Information is to be sent home to parents of students in Year 1 and Year 2 prior to the end of this school term.

Cranbourne East Primary School is once again participating in the Woolworths **Earn and Learn Program** until Tuesday 19th September.

We are aiming to collect 40,000 stickers this year, beating our 2015 total 38,126.

Congratulations on our current total of 22,538 stickers – keep those Earn and Learn stickers coming!

What is Bullying?

Bullying is an ongoing misuse of power in relationships through repeated verbal, physical and/or social behaviour that causes physical and/or psychological harm. It can involve an individual or a group misusing their power over one or more persons. Bullying can happen in person or online, and it can be obvious (overt) or hidden (covert).

Bullying of any form or for any reason can have long-term effects on those involved, including bystanders.

Single incidents and conflict or fights between equals, whether in person or online, are not defined as bullying.

Behaviours that do not constitute bullying include:

- Mutual arguments and disagreements (where there is no power imbalance)
- Not liking someone or a single act of social rejection
- One-off acts of meanness or spite
- Isolated incidents of aggression, intimidation or violence.

However, these conflicts still need to be addressed and resolved.
