### Message from the Principal

Hi everyone

Welcome back to school! I trust all members of our school community were able to enjoy the rest, recharge and take time out during the school holidays. Our students have very quickly re-engaged to their learning, and it is wonderful to see the enjoyment and enthusiasm shown by our students and staff across all levels of the school.

As we return to school we welcome Amy Forscutt to the Acting Assistant Principal role at the school for Term 3. We also welcome Leiticia Burley to an office administration role and on Monday we were able celebrate Leiticia's birthday on her first day of work at CEPS. Welcome to Perri Wilkinson, Hayley Davies, Emily Pither and Renee Drozdzyński returning to teaching roles and Maheeka Perera and Candice Hateley returning to school in Student Inclusion Support roles.

The school is commencing the planning process for school operations in 2022. This includes resourcing the curriculum, teaching and learning programs, workforce planning, facility requirements etc. Part of this planning process is confirming student enrolments to ensure we have sufficient staff, resources and buildings to meet the needs of the school. Parents and carers who are yet to contact the school to enrol their children for school in 2022 are asked to call or send an email to the office for an enrolment pack.

School tours by appointment for new and prospective parents will commence with easing of restrictions and once we return to on-site face to learning. Please contact the office to make an appointment for a school tour.

Have you ever thought about what goes on at the school during the term holidays? The school holidays are a very busy and ideal time for the following scheduled works program to occur: Inspections of all fire services and equipment, emergency lighting and servicing of gas heaters and air conditioning. Condition audits were conducted (and where required replacement) of carpets and vinyl surfaces, blinds, shade-sails and playground equipment. Ongoing maintenance of gardens and grounds including mowing of the grassed areas continues throughout the year.

A deep clean of the entire facility included: internal and external windows, skylights, light fittings, ceiling fans, ducts, grills and vents, gutters cleaned, building eaves washed down and cobwebs removed. The gym floor was scrubbed and buffed. All carpets, soft furnishing and fabric chairs were steam cleaned. Desks, tables and chairs were wiped down.

The canteen, kitchen areas, toilets and changerooms underwent a detailed clean. All internal walls and surfaces, curtains and blinds were spot cleaned. The scheduled works program is a cyclic process to ensure the entire school facility is maintained to the highest standards and is safe and clean for all students, staff and visitors. Ongoing drainage works are continuing on the school oval.
